

Week 3 Assignments

Part 1: Read **Lesson 3** at <http://msporter.yolasite.com>. Toward the end of the lesson, you will see HTML code for a Web page. Create a Web page using exactly the same code. Save your Web page in your Web Design folder. Name this Web page **page3a.html**.

Part 2: Create a Web page named **page3b.html**. In the HTML code, give the page a title of **Text Size and Location**. When complete, this Web page should display the following information. There are 3 parts to this page. In each part, use a different font face (i.e. arial, verdana).

FONT SIZES

There are 7 font sizes that I can use when writing Web pages. The font size you see now is the default font size. There are 4 sizes that are larger than the default font size. The largest of these is **Font Size +4**. **Font Size +3**, **Font Size +2** and **Font Size +1** are also larger than the default font size. There are 2 font sizes that are smaller than the default font size. These font sizes are Font Size -1 and Font Size -2, the smallest of them all.
