

Week 4 Assignments

Part 1: Read **Lesson 15** at <http://msporter.yolasite.com>. Toward the end of the lesson, you will see HTML code for a Web page. Create a Web page using exactly the same code. Name this Web page **page4a.html**. Post your new page on the Internet and test it to make sure that it works.

Part 2: Choose a Web page that you created earlier this semester that contains at least 3 links. Rename the page **page4b.html**. Add JavaScript code to the page to make the following changes:

- Change all of the links on the page so that the text within the links is not underlined.
- Change all of the links on the page so that each link opens a second window, while keeping the current window open.

Post your new page on the Internet and test it to make sure that it works.

Part 3: Choose a different Web page that you created earlier this semester that contains at least 3 links. Rename the page **page4c.html**. Add JavaScript code to the page to make the following changes:

- Ask the person viewing your page to enter his/her name. Somewhere on the page, greet the person (using his/her name) and welcome the person to your page.
- Include the current date and time somewhere on the page.
- Change all of the links on the page so that when your mouse is on the link, text of your choice appears in the status bar at the bottom of the screen.

Post your new page on the Internet and test it to make sure that it works.
